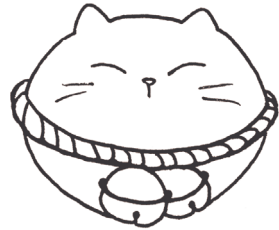
Draw two triangular ears and a semicircular face.

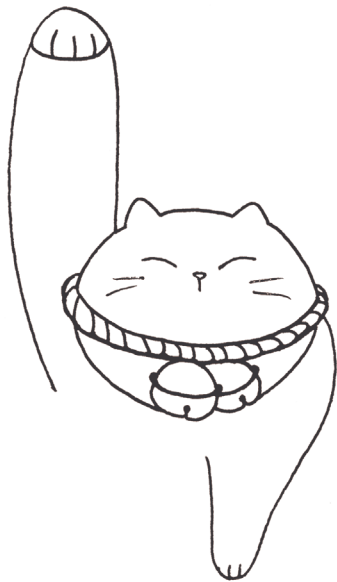
Add a smiley expression.

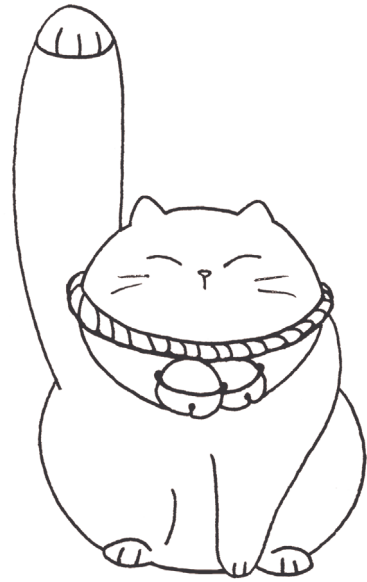
Add a collar and bells.

To bring money and good fortune

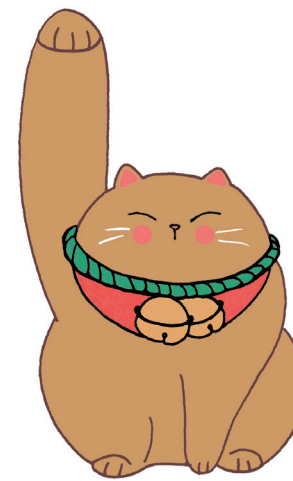
Hammer
