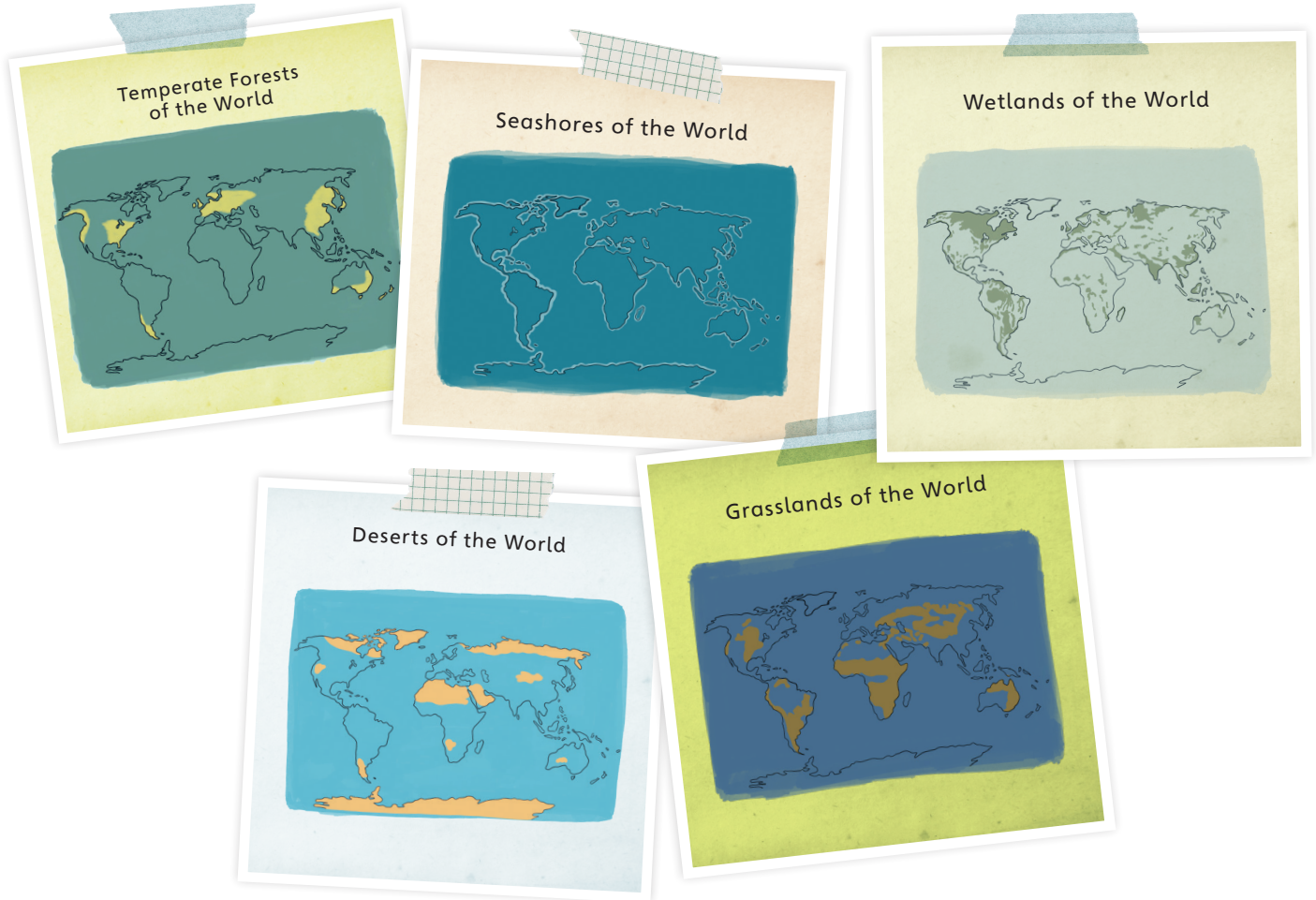


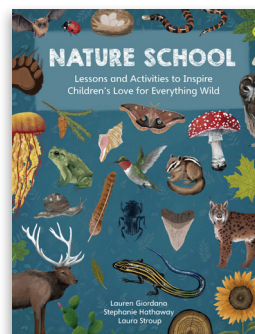
MAPPING THE BIOMES

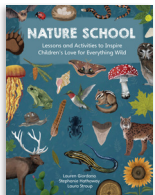

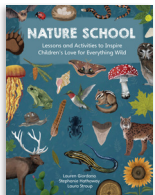
SEASHORES OF THE WORLD

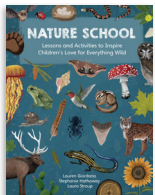
GRASSLANDS OF THE WORLD
